

With an **area of 32,106** square kilometres, Catalonia represents only 6.3% of the Spanish territory.

With a population of **7.5 million**, Catalonia represents 16% of the total Spanish population.

Catalonia's **population** is similar to those of countries like Bulgaria and Austria. Its **GDP** is greater than Denmark's and Finland's and similar to that of Austria.

It **exports** more than Portugal and the Slovak Republic and about as much as Finland and Hungary.


At €27,053 / year, Catalan **GDP per capita** is 14% above the European average (EU-27) and above those of United Kingdom and Italy.





Our aim is to ensure that these investments are economically and technologically sound, and generate wealth and stable, quality employment over the long term in Catalonia.






